I am still puzzling over the many hundred pages of the judgment of the Tribunal. But my interest isn't as keen as you might think. Frankly, I'm very tired of it all. And for this reason have not settled down to a real study.

Am still waiting on word from the U. S. on my habeas corpus petition. No one seems to really appreciate my points and I wonder if it isn't because they don't understand them. Don't understand them because they haven't put in the long study that I have on the constitutional points involved.
